CHICAGO - [The UIC women's tennis team capped off their regular season with a 7-0 victory over Green Bay on Sunday, taking a seven match winning streak into next weekend's Horizon League Championship.](#)

[Mariya Kovaleva, Cristescu, Kristen McPhillips, Jellish and Reisch all went undefeated in league singles action this season, with Antakova falling in only one singles match against a conference opponent.](#)
